A gem in teens' eyes!




Danger! Global Warming!

Is there any way we can do better to alleviate global warming?




Do ghosts really exist?

Meaning: a place that has been abandoned and is no longer inhabited.


Example: This place is like <u>a ghost town</u> now that the tourists have gone home.
